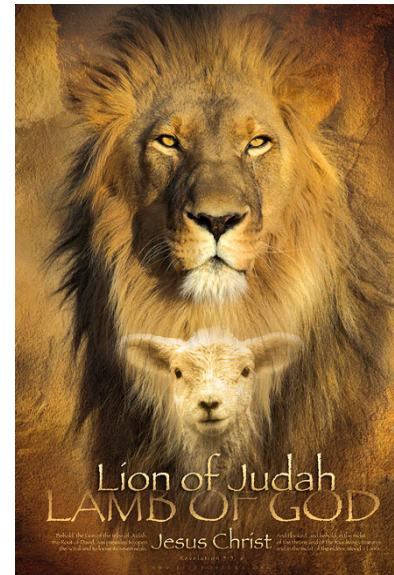
CONTENTS & STRUCTURE REVELATION

The coming of the Messiah, with both the judgments and the rewards, was the great hope and expectation within Judaism and Christianity, based upon the prophecies of the Old Testament and the teaching of the New Testament.



The book of Revelation is both a hearing experience and an imaginary painting of this expectation of the arrival of the 'Day of the Lord', with Jesus as the center point. He is both the suffering Lamb of God and the resurrected and glorified soon coming King of Kings.

John wrote what God gave him, inspired by the Holy Spirit and the Holy Scripture, to encourage his brothers and sisters to continue witnessing or to exhort them to live a holy life, by vividly painting before their eyes both the eternal judgment and the eternal glorious rewards.



It is both destined for his own contemporaries and for his future fellow believers, those saints living in the last days and in the final 'Day of the Lord'.
